

I would like to thank you all for your gracious support of the youth group, especially in allowing another great trip to the Tennessee Christian Teen Convention in Gatlinburg, TN, Jan 9th -11th. As usual, TCTC served as an awesome time for our youth to come together in worship and devotion with each other and with thousands of others from across the region. This year TCTC hosted Christian artist Colton Dixon, illusionist Harris III, worship led by the Southeast Christian Church praise band, and speaker Andrew Jit. The theme of this year's conference was "More Than". The speaker, Andrew Jit, led us through four sessions with sermons addressing the topics: "I am more than my Labels", "I am more than my Circumstances", "I am more than my Failures", and "The Gospel Is for more than just me". The Apostle Peter served as a common thread throughout each of these sermons. After some discussion with the youth many of us agreed that our favorite moment of TCTC this year came during Andrew Jit's message on Saturday night. Without a single note, Jit recited every book in the Bible along with a name for Jesus specific for that book. For example, in Genesis He is the seed of woman, in Exodus He is the Passover Lamb, in Leviticus He is our High Priest; etc. Finally, after reaching Revelation, where He is the One who was, who is, and who is to come, Jit asked the question, "if He is the center of the universe, why isn't He the center of your life?" This was just one of many powerful moments from TCTC 2026. Furthermore, we enjoyed a great time of fellowship throughout the weekend including devotions, meals, and having a good time in Gatlinburg. Again, I want to say thank you all for your support in making this year's trip possible. Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 6:2, "For God says, "At just the right time, I heard you. On the day of salvation, I helped you." Indeed, the "right time" is now. Today is the day of salvation." There is no better time begin walking with the Lord than right now. 
First, we must be attending ourselves. Especially those who have children. Every church says that young people are the future of the church. If so we need to make sure that we always maintain a great children's program.






On Sunday, Jan. 11th FCC had a special Worship Service focusing on the Ordination of Kevin Long as Elder and Del Moody as Deacon.
